



Rules: Clear Creek Swimming League, Inc. 2022 Handbook of Swimming –

Section II, Part V, and Championship Meet Series rules will govern this meet. These rules are listed at the end of this invite. All matters not

specifically dealt with in this section on the Championship Meet Series will be governed according to the rules of the CCSL for dual and tri-meets – Clear Creek Swimming League, Inc. 2022 Handbook of Swimming –

Section II, Parts I – IV.

Order of Events: Events EXCLUDING RELAYS AND 6U EVENTS WILL be conducted in

the order outlined in the Clear Creek Swimming League, Inc. 2022

Handbook of Swimming.

8U will be going off the deck end of pool.

Eligibility: The Last Chance Meet is open to all swimmers listed on their team's roster

as of 6/25/2022 and who have completed a minimum of two (2) CCSL Sanctioned swim meets (regular season). Times from the Last Chance

Meet may be used as seed times for the CCSL Champ Series but

participation in the Last Chance Meet does not count towards the minimum sanctioned meet requirement.

Entry Information:

Swimmers will not be allowed to swim an event in which they have already achieved a 2022 Champ Series qualifying time. If a swimmer swims an event that they have a champ time in, and the original time will be used for seeding at Champ Meet and not the LAST CHANCE time. There are no limits on the number of eligible events a swimmer may enter in their age group. Swimmers may enter with NT. On-time entries and collection of fees are the responsibility of each team.

Hy-Tek Meet Entry Files with a TOP TWO TIMES REPORT PER
TEAM should be submitted as an attachment via e-mail to the Valerie
Richardson at bbaswimteam@gmail.com no later than noon, Monday,
July 11th, 2022. All entries after this time are considered on-deck entries
and will need to be paid for in cash at the registration table at the meet no
later than 5:00pm. Events 1-10 will be pre-seeded and NO on deck entries
will be allowed.

Last Chance can NOT be used to improve seed times. Swimmers must have reserve time or slower to be entered. Time will be verified by the Last Chance clerking team. A coach from each team should plan to be present otherwise a \$50.00 fee may be imposed on the Team Champ Fees. The only exception to this is if a Coach has planned with other individual coaches. Teams that will not be present should email Valerie Richardson indicating they will not be in attendance.

Records will be recognized by the League

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are \$7.00 per swimmer per individual event (Checks from teams only accepted)
On-Deck Entries \$10.00 per swimmer per individual event

Checks should be made payable to BBAC for on time entries from teams only and On Deck Entries will be CASH Only

Each team will be held liable for entries submitted on-time, no exceptions. Payment for on-time entries is due no later than 4:45 p.m. at the meet to the Valerie Richardson. On-deck entries will only be accepted at the registration table between 3:30-5:00 p.m. Tuesday July 12, 2022. Events 1-10 will be pre-seeded and NO ON DECK entries will be allowed for this event. No entries will be accepted after 5:00 p.m. ALL ON

DECK ENTRIES WILL BE ENTERED WITH "NT". On-deck entry fees are \$10.00 per swimmer per event & shall be paid in full at the time of entry. Personal checks will not be accepted for on-deck entries. CASH ONLY.

Scratches and No Shows:

Scratches must be submitted to the Clerk Office no later than 4:45 pm along with payment. If a swimmer is not scratched by this time, they are still responsible for entry fees. If a swimmer misses an event or block scratches NO refunds will be issues.

Protests and Meet Results:

All protests concerning official's decisions and times must be brought to the Meet Director by the official Team Representative within THIRTY MINUTES of official posting of results. **No protest or complaint** lodged by any other person will be entertained. All protests will take place in the Admin Office. Once the protest is received in writing the Meet Director or Coordinator will be contacted. Together the official Team Representative and a Meet Director or Coordinator will take the protest to the Meet Referee. Decisions rendered by the Meet Referee on protests of this type shall be binding and final. Please make sure you have a valid protest before bringing it to the Meet Director/Coordinator

Hospitality Suite: A SMALL Hospitality Suite will be provided each day for (working)

Officials and Coaches only.

Concessions: Concessions will be available.

Facility Rules:

This facility is rented to the Baytown Buccaneers and Sterling High School Booster Clubs under the condition we comply with the following. Violations of these rules may result in you being expelled from the premises and the meet.

- No Smoking or Tobacco Products or Alcohol in or around property.
- No set up is allowed anywhere inside the pool, on baseball fields/track/football field/tennis courts, or in the bleachers of pool. Bleachers in the pool will be designated for watch and go only. Bleachers will be cleared accordingly.
- Special needs areas will be available. Family set up in the bleachers for special needs will be allowed.

 Arrangements must be made in advance with a member of the Meet Coordinator
- No CLIMBING ON STANDS/bleachers IN GYMs. NO writing on walls, floors, plastic coverings, etc. Any violation of this rule will result in removal from the meet and a fine may be assessed to the individuals team for any damage incurred.
- No Noise makers, balls (of any kind), hacky sacks, and similar objects are permitted on the pool deck, or inside the facility. **Violators will be asked to move from the pool area**.
- Swimmers may not have any electronic devices in the ready area, or competition area (pool deck).
- Any damages to property will be the responsibility of individual causing damage, swimmer or parents and team.

Parent's and Swimmer's Responsibilities:

It is the responsibility of each Coach, Parent and Swimmer to follow the League's Code of Conduct, the facility rules, and League Rules (see below). **Any breach of these may/will result in removal from the meet grounds and future league events**.

Clear Creek Swim League Code of Conducts

Below are Clear Creek Swim League's Code of Conduct for Coaches, Swimmers, and Parents. Please make sure that all your families are aware of CCSL Code of Conduct for all members and coaches. Any violation of these codes of conducts, violation of facility rules or the rules set forth by this committee may result in removal from the Champ Series.

Coach Code of Conduct

I hereby pledge that:

- I will provide positive support, care and encouragement for the swimmers participating in the Clear Creek Swim League.
- I will be responsible for all the kids on my team.
- I will do my best to ensure that all the kids have fun.
- I will treat all kids with respect and avoid negative criticism.
- I will teach all kids the skills of swimming, the values of teamwork and the meaning of good sportsmanship.
- I will lead by example and always demonstrate good sportsmanship during all CCSL events.
- I will know the rules and always play by the rules.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during meets.
- I will communicate with the parents on my team and inform them of all team and league rules.
- I will respect all facilities and equipment made available for my team and the league.
- I will not use profanity, abusive language or threatening behavior towards any swimmer, parent, coach or official.
- I will refrain from the use of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco at all CCSL sanctioned activities.
- I will provide a safe situation and use coaching techniques appropriate for each swimmer.
- I will remember that I am a CCSL Swim coach, and my behaviors should reflect the values of our league.

Parent Code of Conduct

I hereby pledge that:

- I will provide positive support, care and encouragement for my swimmers participating in the Clear Creek Swim League.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all swimmers, coaches, and
 officials at every meet, practice, or other CCSL events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my swimmer ahead of personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

- I will demand an environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all CCSL sanctioned activities.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my swimmer to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will do my best to assist with the functions of meets knowing that without volunteers, there can be no
 event.
- I will ask my child to treat other swimmers, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I promise to communicate through the team coach or other team representative. I understand that concerns and constructive criticisms are welcome and should be expressed away from swimmers.
- I promise to share my concerns pertaining to the behavior of meet officials, coaches, spectators, or other volunteers with the appropriate League Representative.
- I promise to fulfill my financial obligations.

Swimmer Code of Conduct

I hereby pledge that:

- I will accept responsibility for my participation by following this Swimmer's Code of Conduct Pledge.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow swimmers, coaches, officials and parents at every meet and practice by demonstrating good sportsmanship.

- I will treat my coaches, other swimmers, officials and fans with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities, and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I deserve to have fun during my CCSL experience and will alert parents or coaches if it stops being fun!
- I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and expect adults to refrain from their use at all CCSL sanctioned activities.
- I will encourage my parents to be involved with my team in some capacity because it is important to me.
- I will do my very best in school.
- I will remember that swimming is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
